Salus at Drexel University offers a Master of Science in Clinical Optometry (MSCO) with an Advanced Studies Certificate degree program for international ophthalmic practitioners desiring to advance their knowledge and skills in optometric care. Students enrolled in this degree program also experience specialized training within a specific content area. This degree program features biomedical and visual sciences, clinical sciences, and research design and applications. The program includes 38 semester hour credits delivered over a 12-month period. It is offered as a full-time program of study taking place on the Salus at Drexel University Elkins Park, PA campus or via a hybrid track where students can participate in didactic coursework and examinations delivered online during the first two quarters and then come to campus for hands-on training during the second two quarters.
